■プログラムの特徴

- 英語による講義科目を多数開講（8単位以上の履修がサーティフィケート取得要件）
- ゼミでの研究指導は英語により行い、リサーチ・ペーパーも英語で作成
- 専攻で開講する日本語による授業も履修可能（修士課程の修了要件の単位に算入）
- Global Short-Term Exchange Program（短期集中型の留学プログラム）による国際交流

■サーティフィケート

- 指定の英語科目のうち8単位の履修により、履修証明書（サーティフィケート）を授与

■ Program Features

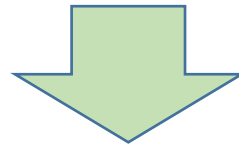
- A wide range of courses offered in English (a certificate is awarded for completing 8 or more credits in GBL courses).
- Research supervision in seminars conducted in English (with students required write a substantial research paper in English).
- The option to take other Japanese-language Business Law courses for full credit.
- An opportunity to study overseas under the Global Short-Term Exchange Program (comprising intensive business law courses offered by international universities).

■ Certificate

- Students who complete 8 or more credits in designated English-taught courses will be awarded a certificate of specialization in addition to their Masters of Business Law degree.

GBL Program : Pre-requisites for Award of a Certificate

Students who

- Satisfy all required curriculum requirements for the Business Law program;
- Enroll in the GBL seminar in every semester of the two-year program; and
- Complete at least 8 credits in designated English-taught GBL courses among the required 22 or more credits in electives.



Students who satisfy the above criteria will be awarded a **GBL Program Certificate** in addition to the Masters of Business Law degree.

Learning and research supervision in English

- GBL supervision seminars are conducted in English.
- Instead of a master's thesis, GBL students write a research paper in English on a focused, practical topic of interest.
- The teaching program is led by three full-time international faculty members:
 - Professor Leon Wolff (Comparative Labor Law, Legal Sociology) (Australian)
 - Associate Professor Stanislaw Piasecki (Information Law, AI and Law) (Polish)
 - Lecturer Davide Totaro (InsurTech, FinTech) (Italian)

The program is further enriched by a diverse group of adjunct professors and guest speakers (see below).

2025年度より、「**Global Short-Term Exchange Program**」を開始

- 海外の提携大学に短期留学し、数週間程度の英語での集中講義を受講
 - 講義時間に応じて、1単位または2単位を認定

 - GBLプログラム以外の学生も参加可能（英語力等の条件あり）
- 海外提携大学からの留学生が、日本での講義に参加することも
- 2025年度の実績
 - ワシントン大学（アメリカ）：夏季休暇中の2週間の集中講義；受講有料
 - メルボルン大学（オーストラリア）：通年開講の1週間のLLMコース；受講無料
 - シンガポール国立大学：夏季・冬季休暇中の1-3週間の集中講義；受講無料

 - ゲーテ大学（ドイツ）：国際取引法
 - ミラノ大学（イタリア）：EUビジネス法
 - 国立台湾大学：情報法

International Exchange through the GBL Program

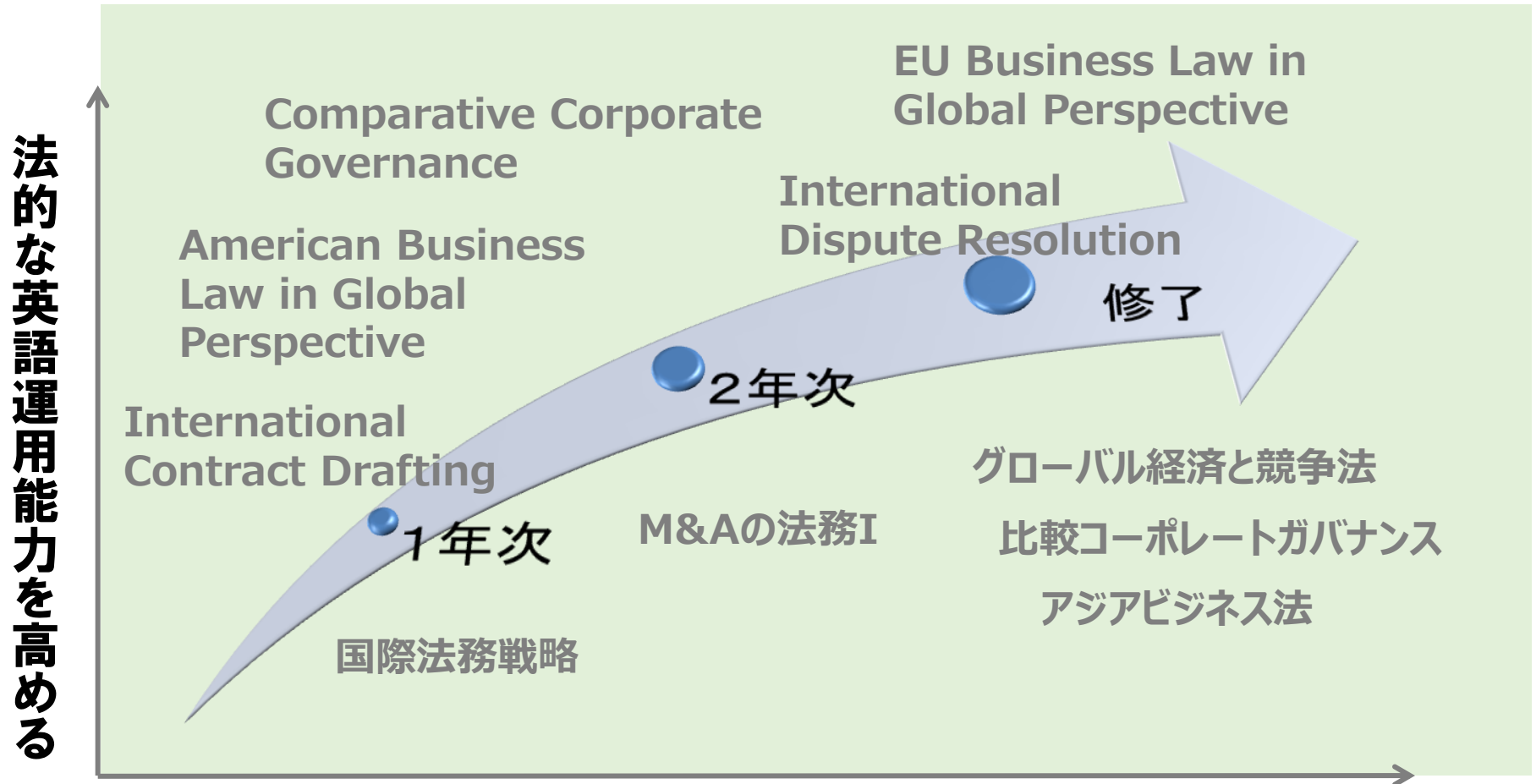
Launch of the Global Short-Term Exchange Program in 2025

- Students will have the opportunity to study abroad by taking intensive (1-3 week courses) at one of our partner universities.
 - Depending on the total instructional hours, students will be awarded either 1 or 2 credits.
 - To receive credits, student enroll in Overseas Intensive in Global Business Law I or II -- see further the [syllabus search system](#).
 - Students outside the GBL Program are also eligible to apply (subject to English proficiency and other requirements).
- Students also have an opportunity to learn alongside international students from our partner universities, a mix of Australian, American, European and Asian law students.
- Programs offered in 2025:
 - University of Washington (US): Two-week summer program in American law; fee-paying
 - University of Melbourne (Australia): One-week LL.M. courses offered throughout the year; tuition-free
 - National University of Singapore: 1-3 week intensive courses offered during the summer and winter breaks; tuition-free
- Planned for 2026 and beyond:
 - Goethe University (Germany): Advising on Global Business Deals
 - University of Milan (Italy): EU Business Law
 - National Taiwan University: Information Law
