Former judge at the International Criminal Court (ICC)

Judge CHUNG served as a high court judge, a district court judge, and a military judge in the Republic of Korea from 1993. From 2008 to 2009, he served as a Legal Advisor and Korean Delegate to the United Nations Commission on International Trade Law (UNCITRAL) at the Embassy of the Republic of Korea and Permanent Mission in Vienna. After that, he served as a United Nations International Judge in the Pre-Trial Chamber of the Extraordinary Chambers in the Courts of Cambodia since August 2011. Judge CHUNG served as a judge at the ICC from March 2015 to July 2025.
